Location

The starting venue is **The London Nautical School**. This is where you will start and finish the walk (5k, 10k and 15k).

The London Nautical School is accessible by road, bus, tube and car. The nearest tube stations are **Waterloo and Southwark**.

Timings

We will be staggering start times between 8pm and 8.40pm. This will spread out groups of walkers along the route. We will let you know your designated start time in August. When you arrive, you'll need to register at The London Nautical School at your allocated time. You will then be taken on the walk, with a reduced number of walkers and an event staff member leading the way.



Groups

We currently plan to have social distanced **groups of 20** walking together along the route.


We will be **following government guidelines** and will notify you of any changes via email and the **Spectrum Night Walks Facebook group**.

The **deadline** to book a place on the Spectrum Night Walks 2021 will be **12pm midday on 9 August**.


Routes

You are able to take part in a **5k**, **10k** or **15k route**, which you can decide on the night if you like. If you do decide ahead of time, letting your supporters know may encourage sponsorship! The routes are as follows:

What about refreshments?

We will have water available at The London Nautical School. Please do bring your own drink with you to minimise contact with others. We will not be serving teas and coffees this year to reduce social contact. We will not be serving any food so please ensure you have had a good meal in preparation for the walk!

Will I need to wear a face covering and use hand sanitiser?

You will need to wear a mask or face covering indoors, unless you are exempt. We recommend that you bring your own and your own hand sanitiser, to use regularly to clean your hands. We will however have a supply of masks and hand sanitiser available at The London Nautical School.

Will there be toilets available?

Toilets are available throughout the event at The London Nautical School.

Will I get a medal?

Absolutely! These will either be given to you on the night after completing your walk or you will have your medal posted to you following the event.

Do I need to raise the £100 per participant minimum sponsorship?
